IN BREAKING NEWS, POPE FRANCIS HAS DIED. HE WAS

HALLOWEEN ARRIVES EARLY THIS YEAR WITH RYAN

THE FILM WAS RELEASED THIS PAST FRIDAY AND HAS MADE \$45.6 MILLION DOLLARS OPENING WEEKEND. IT FINISHED AT NUMBER ONE AT THE BOX OFFICE, SURPASSING THE MINECRAFT MOVIE, WHICH GROSSED \$41 MILLION DOLLARS IN ITS THIRD WEEK IN THEATERS. THE HORROR FILM HAS ALSO HAS A NINETY-EIGHT PERCENT RATING ON ROTTEN TOMATOES, THE SEVENTH HIGHEST FOR A FILM IN 2025.

THIS JUST IN, JUSTICE SAMUEL ALITO HAS ANNOUNCED THE RECENT RULING BY THE U.S. SUPREME COURT TO TEMPORARILY HALT THE DEPORTATION OF VENEZUELAN MIGRANTS HELD IN TEXAS UNDER THE 1798 ALIEN ENEMIES ACT IN A SCATHING DISSENT. IN RESPONSE TO AN APPEAL BY

THE AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION, WHICH CLAIMED THAT THE MIGRANTS WERE BEING DEPORTED WITHOUT FOLLOWING THE PROPER LEGAL PRODUCERS. THE COURT ISSUED A LATE-NIGHT EMERGENCY ORDER WITHOUT PROVIDING A THOROUGH JUSTIFICATION.

THE ISSUE REVOLVES AROUND THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION'S ATTEMPT, BASED ON CONNECTIONS TO THE TREN DE ARAGUA GANG, TO DEPORT VENEZUELAN INMATES FROM THE BLUEBONNET DETENTION CENTER IN NORTHERN TEXAS. ACCORDING TO THE ACLU, THESE DEPORTATIONS GO AGAINST EARLIER SUPREME COURT DECISIONS THAT GUARANTEE JUDICIAL REVIEW PRIOR TO REMOVAL. ALTHOUGH THERE IS LITTLE PROOF CONNECTING THE INDIVIDUALS TO CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR, THE ADMINISTRATION HAD ALREADY STARTED DEPORTING THEM TO AN EL SALVADORIAN PRISON.

THE COMPLEXITY OF IMMIGRATION LEGISLATION AND THE DISTRIBUTION OF AUTHORITY ACROSS THE GOVERNMENT'S BRANCHES ARE HIGHLIGHTED BY THE SUPREME COURT'S INTERVENTION. THE FATE OF THE ARRESTED VENEZUELAN MIGRANTS IS STILL UP IN THE AIR WHILE THE LEGAL STRUGGLE RAGES ON.

ANOTHER STORY JUST IN, POLICE TAKE DOWN STABBING ARSON SUSPECT AT MARYLAND'S NATIONAL HARBOR. AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING TOOK PLACE ON EASTER SUNDAY IN NATIONAL HARBOR, MARYLAND. POLICE SAY AROUND EIGHT AM OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A STABBING CALL, WHERE A MAN AND WOMAN WERE FOUND WITH "CRITICAL STAB WOUNDS" BEFORE FLEEING THE SCENE.

"THE SUSPECT ALSO SET FIRE TO THE APARTMENT" PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT CHIEF MALIK AZIZ SAID DURING A MEDIA CONFERENCE. OFFICERS LEARNED THE

STABBING WAS DOMESTIC-RELATED AND THE SUSPECT WAS  
KNOWN TO THE VICTIMS.

LESS THAN TWO HOURS LATER, OFFICERS RESPONDED TO THE  
NATIONAL HARBOR WHERE THEY ENCOUNTERED THE SUSPECT  
IN THAT EARLIER STABBING AT SAINT GEORGE BLVD AND  
POTOMAC PASSAGE. THE SUSPECT WAS STILL ARMED WITH A  
KNIFE AND MOVED TOWARDS AN OFFICER. TWO OFFICERS  
DISCHARGED THEIR DUTY WEAPONS, AZIZ SAID. THE SUSPECT  
WAS STRUCK AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF TIMES. THE SUSPECT  
WAS TAKEN TO A NEARBY HOSPITAL WHERE HE LATER DIED.  
NO OFFICERS WERE INJURED IN THE INCIDENT.
